Reporting directly to the ship's Captain, each EO also maintains a secondary reporting line with their Compliance Officer-Environmental ashore, ensuring effective communication and coordination across all levels of our environmental management framework.

Our brands are committed to fostering environmental consciousness among our guests. Through various media channels, we disseminate valuable environmental awareness information to passengers. Our EOs are readily available to address any environmental inquiries guests may have, offering insights into maritime environmental management for those interested. SCOPE OF ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Oversees and supports shipboard teams in adhering to environmental policies and procedures.
- Identifies, assesses, and communicates environmental compliance risks, collaborating with shipboard teams to mitigate and prevent non-compliance.
- Conducts environmental rounds and inspections to evaluate the ship's compliance with Company and regulatory environmental requirements globally.
- Assists crew in addressing environmental concerns and questions regarding Carnival's Environmental Management System and relevant environmental requirements.
- Provides shipboard environmental training for all crew members and assesses their environmental proficiency, offering additional training as needed.
- Assists the Captain, Chief Engineer, and local authorities in managing accidental releases or spills.
- Participates in shipboard management meetings to ensure environmental matters are addressed.
- Evaluates and recommends new methods to minimize the ship's environmental impact, including waste minimization, water and energy conservation, and other measures.
- Reviews and communicates environmental restrictions to support voyage planning.
- Ensures proper notification and reporting of all environmental incidents as required.
